Education Opportunities:

Child Development Associate Credential (CDA): The most widely recognized certification in early childhood education. Obtaining a CDA requires 120 hours of class instruction, plus an additional 480 hours of preschool classroom experience. Classes are held once a week and follow a school-year schedule. Enrollment is open the first of every month.

Financial Wellness: Gain knowledge and skills on components of financial wellness: financial literacy, job readiness, and post-secondary education. Working one-on-one with a case manager, client's eliminate barriers and work towards goals. Applications are accepted online, year-round, with an onlin orientation held each week.

- i. Financial Literacy: Introduction to money management basics, budgeting, savings and banking, understanding credit and debt, and creating a financial wellness plan.
- ii. Job Readiness: Career exploration, resume development and job readiness skills building, such as, digital and in-person interview prep, job searches and personal branding.
