Services & Eligibility:

Rent and Deposit Assistance: Our rental assistance program helps households that have experienced a temporary financial crisis beyond their control achieve self-reliance. Clients must have a current lease in place or be able to sign a lease. Financial assistance may cover deposits or rent only. Payments are made directly to the landlord or property management company.

Landlord-Tenant Mediation: This service may help maintain housing and avoid evictions through mediation. Our landlord-tenant mediation program navigates conflicts between landlords and tenants. This service assists with landlord/tenant education and tenant rights. To reach our landlord-tenant mediation program, please call (801) 214-3109 or email mediation@utahca.org

Homeless Services: Utah Community Action provides intake and diversion services at all of the Homeless Resource Centers in Salt Lake County. If you need more information about homeless services or bed availability, please call (801) 990-9999.

You may be eligible for Case Management & Housing if the following applies to your household:

- You are experiencing a temporary financial crisis
- You are a current resident of Salt Lake or Tooele Counties
- You have a current lease in place, or have identified a lease to sign

Priority is given to: Families with children, single-parent households, seniors, individuals with disabilities, Veterans, victims of domestic violence, and formerly homeless families.
